RESIZING IMAGES FOR CLUB COMPETITIONS:

IN PHOTOSHOP GO INTO IMAGE SIZE

A BOX WILL DROP DOWN AND YOU WILL BE GIVEN THE OPTIONS TO CHANGE THE SIZES.

FOR LANDSCAPE IMAGES MAKE THE WIDTH 1600 PIXELS

FOR PORTRAIT IMAGES MAKE THE HEIGHT 1200 PIXELS

THE RESOLUTION OF 72 PIXELS IS FINE FOR DPI

TICK THE RESAMPLE BOX AS THIS ALLOWS YOU TO SET THE IMAGE PIXEL DIMENSIONS.

I HAVE INCLUDED TWO EXAMPLES ON THE NEXT PAGE SHOWING THE IMAGE SIZE BOX

Example 1 - On this image the width is 1600 but the height is only 1032. This is fine as for Landscape images it is the width has to be 1600



Example 2 - On this image the height is 1200 pixels but the width is only 830 pixels again this is fine as the height is the important size for portraits i.e. 1200 pixels
