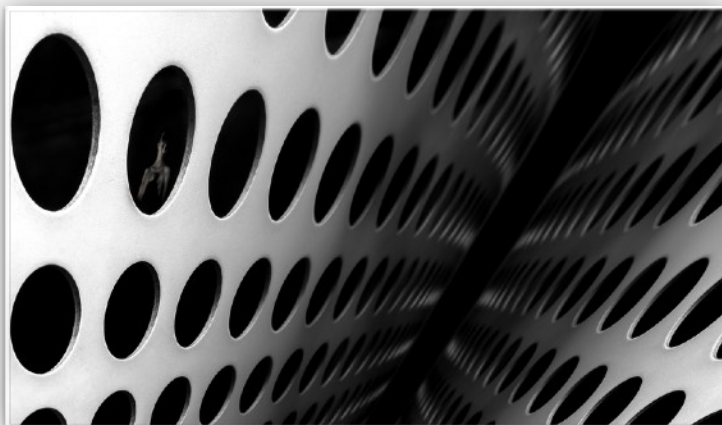
WCPF Knightshayes Trophy 2020
