A REFRESHER FOR THOSE PEOPLE WHO STRUGGLE WITH RESIZING IMAGES :

IN PHOTOSHOP GO INTO 'IMAGES SIZE' AND A BOX WILL DROP DOWN

FOR A LANDSCAPE PICTURE MAKE THE WIDTH 1600 PIXELS

FOR A PORTRAIT PICTURE MAKE THE HEIGHT 1200 PIXELS

THE RESOLUTION OF 72 PIXELS IS FINE FOR A DPI

TICK THE RESAMPLE BOX AS THIS ALLOWS YOU TO SET THE PIXEL DIMENSIONS. (see illustration on page 3)
